Changing From Polypropylene to Polyethylene.



Throughout the years we have continually kept up-to-date with advancements and innovative technology to ensure the charm of the much-loved Topper isn't lost, only suitably adapted for modern sailing requirements. In 2023, our original production method of injection


moulding was updated to our signature rota-moulding technique used on Topper International's Topaz range. And at the same time we have taken the chance to make a few improvements to the sailing experience. This change will safeguard the future of this iconic design, and bring it bang up to date.

Manufacture.

One of the key factors in the success and longevity of the Topper lay in the remarkable sophistication of the manufacturing process.

Until now it has been moulded in polypropylene, an advanced polymer which combines strength and resistance to cracking. Lightweight too, the production process was pioneering for the time and claimed virtually everlasting life! And with some 1970s and 80s boats still being sailed and raced today, we were not wrong!

So how could we make the iconic Topper even better? Well we just have!

What's Changing?

On the Hull.

Rather than a separate hull and deck assembled together, the hull will now be made in one piece. This means no more leaks, or joins to maintain!

The self bailer position has now been relocated to the centre of the cockpit to ensure an even drain. Also, the bailer on the underside now sits flush - so no more protruding screws! We have added three storage hatches to the deck, so sailors can take much needed sustenance out on the water, and introduced adjustable toe straps to suit all ages.

A Mast step liner has also been added, to protect the integrity of the hull and a protective Daggerboard rubber and plate stop too!


If all of that wasn't enough, the race kits will now also come equipped with the new stealth carbon tiller as standard!

Parts Compatabilty.

The rig and foils will stay exactly the same and are interchangeable. As before, there are 3 rigs; The 4.2 for lighter sailors, the ever popular 5.3, and the new 6.4 for continuation & development.

The New Process.

The three layer TRILAM sandwich guarantees that no other rota-moulded sailboat can compare in terms of strength, rigidity and durability. With a lightweight, extra-strength honeycomb core and exceptional Metalicence outer and inner skin, it ensures toughness without increasing hull weight.



Over 40 years in continuous production, it is the outstanding build quality and unique features that keep Topper one of the most popular boats in the world.

Only One Standard



The Price of Excellence.

Over a million pounds was invested in the original tooling for the Topper sailboat and it is this investment in quality that has underwritten the ongoing success.

The two main mouldings of the Topper are fuse welded together to produce a robust single unit. Specially shaped poron blocks are fitted at this stage to provide extra stiffness and provide enormous reserves of positive buoyancy in the unlikely event of Topper's tough skin being holed. The hull has integral buoyancy ensuring positive buoyancy even when flooded. When the Topper is inverted it has an air-pocket ensuring that it is an incredibly safe boat.



Designed Without Compromise.

The fittings and equipment have all been designed to match the high moulding standards. Innovative solutions were developed to achieve a boat that was exceptionally easy to rig and sail. Clever design features include a swivelling mastgate that enables you to erect the mast single-handed.

The daggerboard and rudder blade are moulded in polyethylene which is extremely tough and hard wearing. The brilliant rudder system allows the blade to be set and locked in any position at the flick of a wrist. The vertical nature of the rudder ensures a positive but light control. And the hull plate can survive the boat coming ashore at high speed with the daggerboard still down!

The rig is an un-stayed Bermudan rig.
The aluminium mast is in two sections allowing the spars to be stored within the length of the boat.
The sail has a luff tube which makes rigging really easy.

The sail can be reefed around the mast when the wind increases - or to reduce the sail area for teaching young children to sail in confidence.


The 4.2 m² sail option allows eight and nine year old Topper sailors and the smaller older ones to compete alongside the bigger sailors. The small sail is really inexpensive and it's pretty quick in the hands of a 30-40kg sailor. It also doesn't require a new mast or a change of controls. A single sail manufacturer makes sail measurement unnecessary.

Sail controls are through a single mainsheet ending in the centre of the cockpit. The Race Topper rig comprises a 6:1 downhaul, 4:1 outhaul and 3:1 kicker or vang. These controls are similar to that found in a Laser.

Circuit Racer.

Because of the exceptional quality of the rota-moulding process and the builder's policy of total uniformity in the specification of fittings and equipment, Toppers are completely identical in every way. Small variations to improve the efficiency of the rig controls are permitted, but nothing whatsoever that could affect actual boatspeed is allowed.


